REGULATION

on level inclusion criteria in AIVANCRATE

dated March 24, 2026

Preamble

This Regulation defines the conceptual framework, procedure, and criteria for adding levels to the AIVANCRATE list.

AIVANCRATE is not a list of the Global List / Pointercrate / ILL / UDL type, where, in theory, any levels by any creators may be included subject to generic internal rules. AIVANCRATE is based on a different foundation and a different selection philosophy.

Initially, the AIVANCRATE website was created as an archive and information system for Aivan's levels. As of the date of this edition, approximately 98% of levels in the list fully belong to Aivan, and Aivan has personally contributed to each of them in one or several aspects:

- gameplay;
- decoration;
- verification;
- concept and authorial aura of the level.

The project acknowledges that gameplay and decoration can technically be created by many creators. However, a key condition for considering a level for inclusion is its compliance with the authorial aura of Aivan's world and with the overall creative concept of AIVANCRATE.

AIVANCRATE is treated as a product of Aivan's authorial world, not as a universal public platform for large-scale community submissions.

1. General provisions on review priority

Levels are added under strict rules divided into four categories. Categories are applied in descending order of priority:

- levels meeting Category I criteria have the highest priority;
- levels meeting Category IV criteria have the lowest priority.

If there are grounds for a higher-priority review, a level may be moved to a higher category review path or added in a simplified manner by Aivan's decision.

2. Categories of inclusion criteria

2.1. Category I: inclusion without additional expert checks and voting

Category I includes levels meeting the following conditions:

1. The level is above the baseline requirements for Categories II, III, and IV.
2. The level fully belongs to Aivan and is included in the list without additional formal procedures, at Aivan's discretion.
3. The level contains direct participation by Aivan (see Note 2.1).
4. The level must not have a negative reputation in terms of building quality and verification, both in Aivan's opinion and in the opinion of AIVANCRATE participants. The final decision is always made by Aivan.
5. Levels by persons personally known to Aivan in real life may pass a simplified review procedure at Aivan's discretion.

Note 1. Direct participation means participation recognized and confirmed by Aivan himself.

Note 2. Indirect participation means independent use by other creators of Aivan's name, style, or ideological symbols without direct participation by Aivan.

2.2. Category II: inclusion only after voting

1. The level mostly reflects Aivan's style. Style is defined as a combination of gameplay, decoration, and Aivan's level aura. Non-compliance with at least one of these elements under Aivan's standards disqualifies the level from Category II and above.
2. Levels by persons known to Aivan through online communication may be reviewed in a simplified manner: the higher Aivan's personal trust and positive attitude toward the author, the easier the level review procedure may be.

Voting procedure for Category II. Voting is organized within the AIVANCRATE community. Website voting functionality is planned for future implementation; however, until it is launched, voting is conducted in the AIVANCRATE Telegram channel and Discord server. The voting subject is either adding a level to the list or ignoring the level. Voting dates and result announcement dates are determined by Aivan.

2.3. Category III: inclusion after additional subjective review by Aivan

1. Aivan participated indirectly in the level (see Note 2.1).
2. The level fails to reflect exactly one of the three components of Aivan's style.
3. The level does not yet have a victor.

Subjective review procedure for Category III. The review is conducted by Aivan personally. At Aivan's discretion, close and long-term project participants may be involved in the assessment.

2.4. Category IV: grounds for refusal to include a level

1. The level has nothing in common with the AIVANCRATE concept.
2. Star-rated level. At the same time, an exception is allowed: if a level was added to AIVANCRATE and only later received stars, it may remain in the list unless other grounds for removal arise.
3. Aivan has an extremely negative attitude toward the level.
4. The level is not published on the game servers.
5. Low-effort content is not accepted. This also includes empty short levels, absurd impossible levels, and stolen levels.
6. The level creator is not registered on the website. At the same time, a collaboration may be accepted if the host is registered on the website.
7. One of the level creators has a bad reputation in the AIVANCRATE community, or Aivan refuses to accept levels from that author.
8. Any prohibitive rules published in the project's Telegram channel, on the website (rules section), or on the AIVANCRATE Discord server are violated.

3. Procedure for submitting level inclusion proposals

As of March 24, 2026, the website does not provide built-in functionality for formally submitting a level inclusion request to the AIVANCRATE list.

Until such functionality is published, all preliminary coordination and level proposals shall be sent via:

- the official AIVANCRATE Telegram channel/chat;
- the AIVANCRATE Discord server.

Final provisions

This Regulation enters into force on March 24, 2026, and applies until a new edition is approved.

This document may be revised, supplemented, or amended in the future at Aivan's initiative in case of changes to the list concept, internal project rules, or level review procedures.

All interested persons shall be guided by the current edition of the Regulation published in the project's official channels.

The timing of assessment, review, voting, subjective verification, and final decision-making may vary and fully depends on Aivan's current availability.
